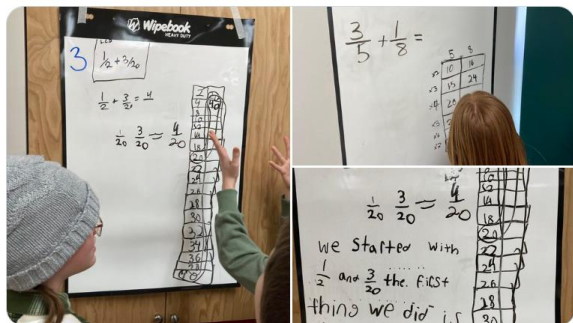


Our strategies:

- Each K-8 staff member was in-serviced on Guided Math, number talks, and received guest instruction from our divisional numeracy consultant, Mrs. Michalysen.
- Teachers began using Guided Math, Number Talks and a multitude of manipulatives.
- Mr. Gamble visited each classroom four times to discuss math instruction to see our teacher's execution of the new skills we had learned together.
- Students participated in regular numeracy assessments to show growth in rational operations over time.
- Following those assessments teachers were able to focus their instruction with individual students and groups during regular guided math lessons.

The result:

Students at WES have built confidence in the area of rational operations, outperforming their previous assessments which is evident in their quiz results and in their problem-solving during number talks in each classroom. Our team plans to continue to use these strategies because of our success!



Our Kindergarten class is learning about skip counting. Organizing numbers together on the board then filling their very own 100 chart highlighting the 10's.
