Our Goals

2023-2024 goals were centred around 3 focus areas: Literacy, Numeracy, and Well-being

Literacy – To continue to develop our structured literacy program, with emphasis in our Grade 3 and 4 classrooms, while Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 classrooms maintain or further develop strategies implemented the previous school year.

Numeracy - To increase student confidence with Rational Operations while implementing NAP MRLC curricula programming.

<u>Well-being</u> - To provide students with strategies and knowledge that will support them in regulating their emotions in various contexts

Literacy -

We purchased materials to support letter and sound recognition in Early Years classrooms and significantly boosted our selection of decodable texts for home reading and classroom instruction. Our Early Years staff participated in structured literacy focused PD opportunities through the ISD continuous improvement plan literacy sessions.

Numeracy -

Our Early Years classrooms created opportunities to practice "hands-on" Math and found examples of Math concepts in our daily lives.

Middle Years teachers organized their numeracy lessons to conform with the NAP program, which included changing the order of units to better support how students learn math

Our Middle Years staff participated in numeracy focused PD opportunities through the ISD continuous improvement plan numeracy sessions.

Wellness -

As a staff we focused on classroom and school-wide community building. Our goal was to establish a culture of kindness and caring within our school. We created opportunities for our Middle Years students to be role models and supports for our Early Years students.

We are continuing to move towards a better awareness of "self-regulation," by providing students with strategies on managing emotions and resolving conflicts in a healthy manner.
